FITZPATRICK SKIN TYPE CLASSIFICATION

- Type I** Very fair, always burns, never tans *Highest pigment contrast — minimal density recommended*
- Type II** Fair, burns easily, tans minimally *High contrast — conservative density, warm pigments*
- Type III** Medium, sometimes burns, tans gradually *Moderate contrast — standard protocols apply*
- Type IV** Olive, rarely burns, tans easily *Low contrast — density can increase, watch warmth*
- Type V** Brown, very rarely burns *Minimal contrast — warm pigments critical, avoid oversaturation*
- Type VI** Dark brown/black, never burns *Lowest contrast — highest oversaturation risk, warm pigments only*

CONTRAINDICATION SCREENING

- Keloid History** Does client have history of keloid scarring? **HIGH RISK**
Y N proceed with test patch only
- Active Skin Condition** Psoriasis, eczema, dermatitis on scalp? **DEFER**
Y N treat condition first
- Blood Thinners** Warfarin, aspirin, or anticoagulant use? **CAUTION**
Y N consult physician, increased bleeding
- Accutane / Isotretinoin** Current or within last 12 months? **DEFER**
Y N skin integrity compromised
- Autoimmune Condition** Alopecia areata, lupus, other? **CAUTION**
Y N unpredictable pigment retention
- Diabetes** Type 1 or Type 2? **CAUTION**
Y N slower healing, infection risk
- Recent Sunburn** Sunburn on scalp in past 2 weeks? **DEFER**
Y N reschedule after full healing
- Active Infection** Folliculitis, ringworm, or open wounds? **DEFER**
Y N treat and clear completely first
- Previous SMP** Existing SMP work from another provider? **ASSESS**
Y N may need laser before retreatment
- Hair Transplant** FUT strip or FUE procedure? **ASSESS**
Y N scar tissue pigment retention varies

SCALP CONDITION

- Oiliness Dry Normal Oily Very Oily
- Elasticity Tight Normal Loose
- Thickness Thin Medium Thick
- Sun Damage None Mild Moderate Severe
